PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Philanthropic citizenship education encourages students to move beyond ideas of 'charity', instead embracing a 'social justice mentality', while focusing on building philanthropic behavior: helping others, local community building, volunteering, social action, charitable giving, advocacy.

The internship is designed to ensure that all youth can contribute regardless of their social, geographic or economic circumstances.

Student-led and adult-facilitated activities ensure that students are challenged to think critically and explore, engage and grow in areas that interest them, all while being inspired and empowered to create lasting impact on children and youth in underserved communities across New York City and the Philippines.






PROGRAM OUTCOMES

IMPACT OPPORTUNITIES

Grant Writing

The role involves researching and identifying potential government and private foundation grant makers, preparing proposals, and managing grant cycle reporting.

Social Media

The role involves developing and implementing effective social media strategies, creating communication calendars, and designing engaging content to promote youth development programs and educator professional development.

Video Production

This role includes planning and implementing all aspects of video projects, creating various types of short videos, and proficiency in video production platforms like Camtasia.

Research

This role involves in-depth knowledge on gathering resources for research, strong organization, interpersonal, time management and written communication skills, strong execution of Google Suite as well as ability to create and manage multiple databases and documents.

Partnerships and Outreach

This role requires someone adept at forming business partnerships, with excellent communication skills, and the ability to create an effective outreach strategy.

Operations

The role involves collaborating with senior leadership to prioritize daily tasks, efficiently managing day-to-day operations, and organizing events to enhance efficiency in achieving the organization's vision of inspiring and empowering children, youth, and teachers in underserved communities.

Web Development

The developer will play a crucial role in enhancing website navigation, maintaining secure web pages, and collaborating with the team to meet web development goals, contributing to the organization's vision of inspiring and empowering students and teachers.

Fundraising

The position entails four main tasks: Research and identify fundraising opportunities and establish relationships with donors; Organize activities to raise funds or otherwise gather monetary donations or other gifts to support MBM's mission; Design and produce promotional materials and raise awareness of the organization's work, goals, and financial needs.
